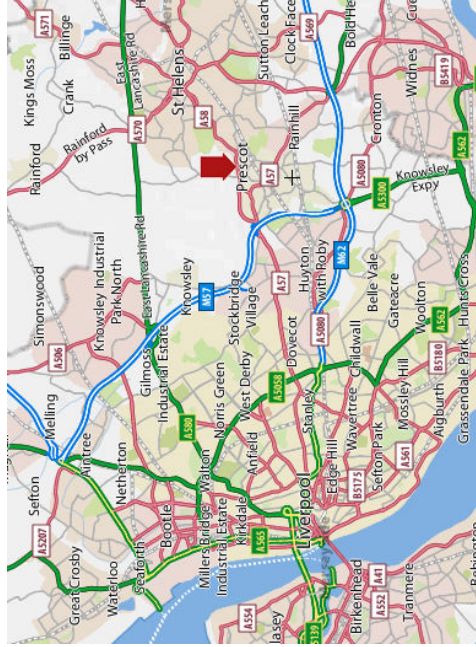

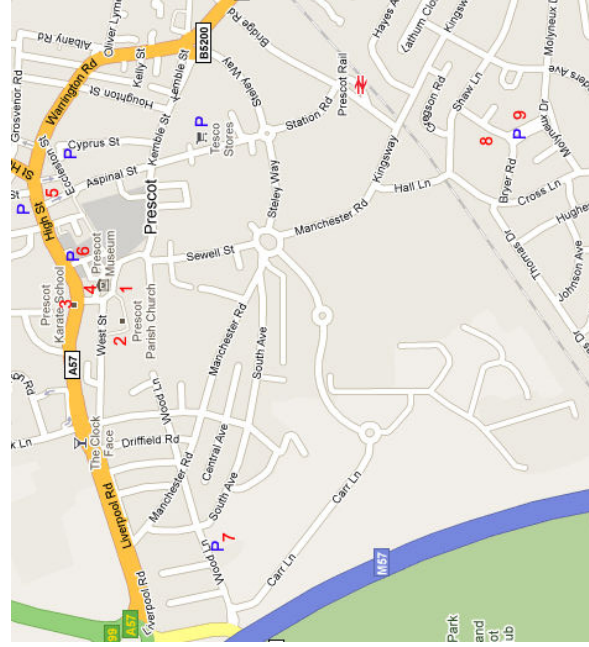
From the M57—Junction 2
